Directions for Use

For a General Purpose mortar, Hydrated Lime should be used in the ratio of 1 Hydrated Lime: 1 Cement: 6 Sand (by volume)

Storage, Handling & Safety

- Care should be taken when handling bagged products as personal injury may occur. It is suggested that when handling bagged materials unless you have been trained to do so, the load is shared with another person.
- If Hydrated Lime comes in contact with the eyes or skin remove the patient from the dusty area and flush thoroughly with clean water for 15 minutes. Remove any contaminated clothing and footwear. Seek medical attention. If the Hydrated Lime is ingested, rinse the mouth and lips with water providing water to dilute the contents of the stomach. Seek immediate medical attention.

Do not use excessive water, use only enough to make the mix workable. Excess water weakens the mortar.

Do not allow the mixed mortar to stand for an extended period of time, as re-tempering the mix with additional water will weaken the mortar.
